Logos

Someone recently said, "Gen-Z loves abbrev's". Abbreviations and words are just symbols for something or an idea, such as "FB" is used for Facebook. Below are a few symbols that we might commonly see around the church.



The symbol of the **United Church of Christ** comprises a crown, cross and orb enclosed within a double oval bearing the name of the church and the prayer of Jesus, "That they may all be one" (John 17:21). It is based on an ancient Christian symbol called the "Cross of Victory" or the "Cross Triumphant." The crown symbolizes the sovereignty of Christ. The cross recalls the suffering of Christ - his arms outstretched on the wood of the cross - for the salvation of humanity. The orb, divided into three parts, reminds us of Jesus' command to be his "witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Sa-

maria and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). The verse from Scripture reflects our historic commitment to the restoration of unity among the separated churches of Jesus Christ. The 1960s logo was refreshed in 2019.



The Comma. Inspired by a quote from Gracie Allen:

"Never put a period where God has placed a comma", the comma reminds us:

- -- of God's boundless love.
- -- that God is still speaking, and that God speaks in multiple ways.
- -- that "There is more truth and light to break forth from God's holy word." (Pastor John Robinson told the Pilgrims as they set sail for the Netherlands).
- --that we are on a continuous faith journey.



The symbol of the basin, pitcher and towel refer to John 13. Jesus stood up from the table, took off his outer robe, and tied a towel around himself. Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet. After he had washed their feet, he told them that they ought to wash one another's feet.

With love and faith He gave his disciples a new commandment, "that you love one another, just as I have loved you, you should love one another." Jesus is our example of servanthood.

Our local church created the logo during a visioning session in June 2014, and artwork was completed by Custom Sports Screen Printing. The logo includes our motto: "Serving God with love and faith".



LE stands for **Linaje Escogido**, which is translated as "chosen lineage". The *j* and the *g* sound like *h*. The name symbolizes 1 Peter 2:9, "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's won people, in order that you may proclaim the

mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light." In the letter, Peter, an apostle of Christ, writes to exiles who have been chosen by God, and made holy by the Spirit to be obedient to Christ. The Garcia family has been leading congregations for at least three generations. The church began in Mexico as a response to an American pentecostal missionary who had moved there.


