Lost and Found

Have you ever lost something you treasured? Did you put it somewhere to keep it safe? Did you loan it to someone? Did you toss it out by accident?

It's easy to lose what we value. The church is wise to offer us the season of Lent. It can be a time to find what is missing in our lives. It can be a time to deliberately search for what we have forgotten, loaned out, or discarded along the way. Lent can be a time to search out, restore, and renew.

Lent is the season to ask: What do I value in my life? What is it that I hide from? Am I missing something in my life? How can I recover what I hold dear?

- Luke 4:42-44 Jesus finds inner renewal in a "lonely place".
- Luke 5:1-11 Faith is found in a catch of fish.
- Luke 7:36-50 A woman finds the peace she has lost.
- Luke 9:10-17 The crowd finds Jesus and he gifts them with nourishment.
- Luke 10:38-42 Mary has found "the better part".
- Luke 11:5-13 Persistence. "The one who searches always finds."
- Luke 19:1-10 The Son of Man has come to seek out and save the lost.


Inspired by God's Spirit, we seek to create radically inclusive spaces and places for faith exploration.

The last of the north non-stained-glass windows was completed in February by Custom Carpentry of Norfolk. The project, which included 72 panes of glass on the North side of the building, began last fall. The task included replacement of cracked panes, new caulking, and painting. The crew of two was able to take advantage of the unseasonably warm weather last month to paint. The project cost \$6425 and was listed in the 'Maintenance' line item in the budget.
